

1980s

- Tom Curtin is hired as Lakeside's first General Manager. Previously, Lakeside corporate business was handled by Lakeside Directors, committee volunteers, seasonal employees, and staff.
- Additional 25 yard lanes are added in back portion of the Lake.
- Demolition of existing concession/bathhouse, and construction of new pavilion building begins in 1982. While under construction, members swam at Crescent Hill Bubble. Lakeside's new building (named for Jack Thompson) was completed for summer of 1983.
- Discussion and plans for new larger pool begin.
- Lakeside is well represented in 1984 Olympics by Tori Trees and Mary T. Meagher.
- Lounge area in Thompson building changed into exercise room.
- Switch from chlorine gas to bleach (sodium hypochlorite) for safer water sanitation.
